This is an event that showcases what our grade 10-12s have been working on in class since the start of September, and it is *a great opportunity to welcome you into our school for the first time since March 2020!*

We are so excited to celebrate with you and come together to support our students as they bravely step forward into live performance once more!

**If we adhere to the CBE regulations around allowing family into the building as spectators, we stand a better chance of being able to stay open and have our doors open to you.**

If requirements for being here are not followed, it is more likely that our doors will ultimately close to outsiders once more, or an outbreak among our staff or students could occur.



## Here's how we keep the doors open and have *more live performances*:

- Grade 10 students are allowed to invite 4 family members and they have given us the names of who is attending.
- Grade 11/12 students are allowed to invite 2 family members and they have given us the names of who is attending.
- Only the family members who were put on the list are permitted to attend. Please bring your ID.
- *Masks must be worn at all times in the school building.*
- Families must sit together in cohorts and be 2m distanced from other family cohorts. This will be pre-arranged by staff and you will be shown where you can sit.
- When you enter the building through the main doors, please look for the Front of House check-in table being run by wonderful parent volunteers and show them your ID to check you in. Please wait in the foyer or hallways until the Theatre doors open for your student's show. Following the show, the teachers will instruct on which doors to exit through, please wait in your vehicles for your children to join you after they have changed out of their costumes and have a little car celebration of their work!
- We need to eliminate crowding in the main foyer as our class audiences overlap – so please do wait in your vehicles at the end of your child's performance instead of in the foyer.
- *Proof of vaccination will not be required in order to attend this event.*
